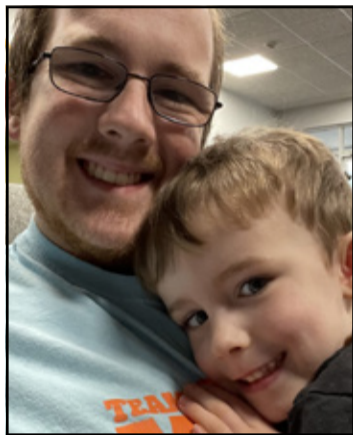

### Ask Rusty – How Does Social Security Disability Work With Private Disability Insurance?

**Dear Rusty:** If someone is collecting long-term disability through their company and the company states the employee also must apply through Social Security, how does this work? Does the amount of Social Security decrease from the amount that the person would normally receive upon retirement? Is long-term disability for life, or just until you are of retirement age? How about for the spouse of that individual? Would it have any impact on them?

**Dear Concerned:** It's common for private long term disability (LTD) insurers to require that you apply for Social

Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) benefits. Typically, the private LTD benefit will be offset (reduced) by the federal SSDI benefit.

The SSDI benefit amount, if awarded, will be the full Social Security benefit earned up to the point the recipient becomes disabled and unable to work. That means someone on SSDI

before full retirement age (FRA) gets their FRA amount earlier (FRA is somewhere between 66 and 67 depending on the year of birth). The SSDI benefit will be based on the disabled person's lifetime earnings history, unreduced for claiming earlier than full retirement age. SSDI

When we were young and in good health it seldom, if ever, occurred to us that one day we would be too old to dance the night away. We were full of vim and vinegar. No one had to tell us that we needed to get more exercise; we were always in motion from the time we woke up in the morning to the time we called it a day -- sometimes in the wee small hours of the next morning. And then, one day, we realized that it was time to slow down.

So we took off our dancing shoes, put on a pair of house shoes and passed the time on a comfy couch reading a book or watching TV. But, just as we began to accustom ourselves, friends, family and our doctors sounded the alarm, telling us that we needed to get more exercise. Go for a long walk, they said. Go to the gym and work

out. They were right, of course: as Sir Isaac Newton put it, "A body at motion stays in motion; a body at rest stays at rest." And, too much rest, can lead us to a final resting place.

Indeed, according to the American Academy of Family Physicians 'Exercise is an important part of nearly everyone's everyday health, including older adults. Experts say seniors should be as active as possible. If you are an older adult, exercise can help you live a longer, healthier life.'

### BBB Says To Be Careful With 'Home Energy Auditor'

Summer is here, and rising temperatures mean high air conditioning bills. Scammers have devised a new con that claims to "save you money." Con artists, posing as local government and utility company representatives, are offering phony home energy audits and services. Here's what you need to know to spot the scam.

How the scam works: You are contacted over the phone or in person at your front door. The "representative" introduces themselves as working for your utility company or with the energy division of your local government. They may even show you identification, but it isn't real.

Scammers inform you that you could be saving big on your

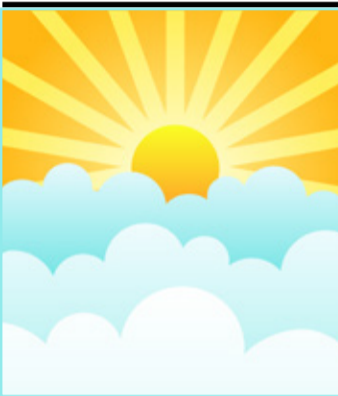

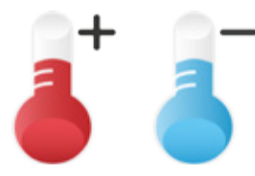

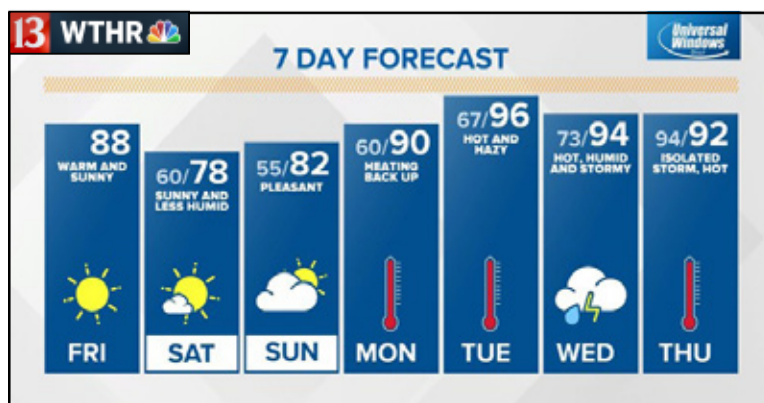

Larry Gene Bennett, 79, of Romney, Ind. passed away at IU Arnett Hospital in Lafayette 9:23 a.m. Thursday June 2, 2022.

He was born in Lafayette March 18, 1943, the son of the late Charles Bennett, Jr. and Frances Lucille Linder Bennett.

He was a 1961 graduate of Linden High School and received his degree in agriculture from Purdue University. He married Glenda K. French at Rossville, Ind. June 30, 2001 and she survives. He resided all of his life in the Linden area, and farmed in the Montgomery and Tippecanoe County area from 1965 until 2001. He later was employed by Utterback Marketing dealing in grain commodities and in 2005 opened RC Hobbies Plus in Lafayette.

He was a member of the Linden United Methodist Church; Lafayette Cloud Jockeys; served as superintendent of the 4-H Llama Club and a member of the NMMTPA (National Micro Mini Tractor Pull Association, where he was the first inductee into their Hall of Fame. He served in the U.S. Army Reserve from 1965 until 1969 and in 1974, he was awarded the National Young Farmer of the Year Award during the President Gerald Ford administration.

Survivors include his wife, Glenda; three daughters, Gena Brown (Kerry) of Lafayette, Stacey Shirar (Darrell) of Lafayette and Andrea Harpenau of Niles, Mich.; a son, Wade Bennett (Mindy) of Linden; and a sister, Diana Meier (Ron) of Huntington, Ind. Also surviving are 11 grandchildren and 12 great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents and a stepson.

The Crawfordsville Fire Department's Mobile Integrated Health team and Mayor Todd Barton presented at the 24th Rural Health Conference and Annual Membership Meeting (IRHA) in French Lick, Ind. this past Tuesday.

The presentation on Tuesday covered the program's successful quick response team and how other rural Indiana communities can implement similar programming with their partners.

"The IRHA conference

is a great opportunity to share our ideas, successes, and challenges with other rural communities who are facing similar health issues related to substance use, behavioral health, infant and maternal health, COVID-19, and more," said Mobile Integrated Health Project Manager Samantha Cravens.

Crawfordsville's Mobile Integrated Health program is a statewide and national leader in addressing rural health challenges. The program was launched as a pilot program for the

## FSSA Asks Hoosiers To Participate In Survey

The Indiana Family and Social Services Administration's Division of Mental Health and Addiction yesterday announced the launch of the Recovery Capital Index, designed to measure the sum of resources necessary for an individual to initiate and sustain recovery from addiction and to help track the overall recovery capital of the state and communities.

"People in recovery have been telling us for decades that there is more to recovery than just maintaining sobriety," said Jay Chaudhary, DMHA director. "A well-rounded, fulfilling life is the key to a thriving recovery. The Recovery Capital Index will help the state measure the quality of life for Hoosiers in recovery and ensure that Indiana remains a great place to recover."

Recovery capital is the overall measure of internal and external resources available to an individual with a substance use disorder to ensure their continual success in recovery. The RCI provides a comprehensive picture of a person's whole well-being using an online, automated 68-question survey. Generally, the higher the level of recovery capital, the better the chances of someone maintaining success in recovery.

The state of Indiana has invested more than \$45 million of federal State Opioid Response grant funding over the past four years to combat

the drug epidemic and improve mental health. DMHA plans to use aggregate and geographically analyzed results from the Recovery Capital Index to drive future decisions about funding and resource allocation. Chaudhary said mapping and measuring recovery capital will also allow DMHA to see the effect of its investment and track it over time.

To complete the Recovery Capital Index survey, text "RECOVERY" to 833-638-3784. All Hoosiers are encouraged to complete the survey, not just those directly affected by addiction.

To help drive participation, Overdose Lifeline, Inc., an Indiana nonprofit dedicated to helping those affected by substance use disorder, will place stickers on over 200 NaloxBox units and 19 naloxone vending machines across the state. The stickers will prompt users to scan the QR code or text "RECOVERY" to 833-638-3784 to access the survey and additional information about naloxone, including training videos.

DMHA has contracted with Commonly Well to administer the survey statewide. Commonly Well is a public benefit company that uses technology and data to help communities and organizations employ well-being initiatives.

## New Scholarship Accounts Give Hoosier Families More Control Over Students' Education

One year after its creation, Indiana's newest scholarship fund is ready to launch! The Indiana Education Scholarship Account Program joins the state's robust catalog of education opportunities and is designed for families seeking to take control of their student's academic journeys. The application window will open for Eligible Students on June 27, 2022.

"After so much preparation, input, and study, we are thrilled to announce the launch of the Indiana ESA Program," said Treasurer of State Kelly Mitchell, who oversees the program. "Families will have more opportunities to meet their child's individual

education needs by taking control of the resources they are entitled to through an Indiana ESA account. I encourage all eligible Hoosiers to consider applying."

The Education Scholarship Account Program provides tax-free scholarship funds to Eligible Students for pre-approved education expenses such as tuition, therapies, assessments, and fee-for-service transportation to spend with pre-approved educational service providers. Funds are not counted as income for families of recipients, nor do funds impact other forms of financial aid (e.g. Medicaid waivers).

For the 2022-23 school year, the application win-

dow for eligible students is June 27-August 5, 2022. Applications can be found online at [www.in.gov/tos/inesa](http://www.in.gov/tos/inesa).

To be eligible for ESA funds, students must meet the following requirements:

- Be a resident of Indiana;
- Are between the ages of 5-22 years old;
- Require special education services and have an Individualized Education Program (IEP), Service Plan (SP), or Choice Special Education Plan (CSEP); and
- Annual income may not exceed 300% of the federal Free and Reduced Lunch income qualification.

for providers now, and can be found on the program's Application page: <https://www.in.gov/tos/inesa/>.

About the Program The Indiana Education Scholarship Account Program will provide students with disabilities throughout the state of Indiana access to funds to set up an educational environment that best meets their learning needs. Parents of Eligible Students, or emancipated Eligible Students, will have the opportunity to spend dedicated scholarship money on approved educational programs, therapies, services, tuition and fees, and other expenses related to the student's education.





# Indiana's May 2022 Employment Report Shows Unemployment Numbers Holding Steady

Indiana's unemployment rate in May remained unchanged from the previous month, holding steady at 2.2%, according to the Indiana Department of Workforce Development (DWD). By comparison, the national unemployment rate in May stood at 3.6%, also remaining stable from April.

In addition, Indiana's labor force participation rate rose again, from 62.6% in April to 62.9% in May, remaining above the national rate of 62.3%. Indiana's total labor force, which includes both Hoosiers employed and those seek-

ing employment, stands at 3,364,365—an increase of 16,374 from the previous month.

"While the number of people working in the private sector is at a new high, there remains numerous available job opportunities throughout Indiana," said DWD Commissioner Fred Payne. "More and more Hoosiers have spent the last several months reassessing their career and career goals, and the May employment report shows individuals continue to return to the workplace."

Private sector employment in Indiana decreased by 5,300 jobs over the

last month, translating to a gain of 105,200 jobs from this time last year. Total private employment now stands at 2,759,300. Industries that experienced job increases in May included:

- Manufacturing (+2,400);
- Professional and Business Services (+2,000); and
- Leisure and Hospitality (+1,000).

As of June 1, 2022, there were 159,763 open job postings throughout the state. The number of people in Indiana that received unemployment benefits during May was 16,902.

will automatically convert to regular SS retirement benefits at the same amount when FRA is attained. Thus, getting SSDI doesn't detract from the person's FRA benefit amount; rather they get their FRA amount earlier.

Social Security disability benefits last for as long as you remain disabled, or up to your SS full retirement age. To be eligible, the disability must be expected to last for at least one year, and the disability must render you unable to perform significant work. You must also have worked recently (usually at least 5 of the last 10 years) to maintain eligibility, and you must have contribut-

ed Social Security FICA payroll taxes (or self-employment taxes) from your work earnings. Only very limited work earnings are allowed when collecting Social Security Disability Insurance benefits, and Social Security may periodically require confirmation of continued SSDI eligibility.

Applying for SSDI is a relatively easy process which can be done online at [www.ssa.gov/applyfordisability](http://www.ssa.gov/applyfordisability), or by calling SS directly at 1.800.772.1213. Depending on the nature of the disability, it usually takes 3 to 5 months to obtain a determination and, if SSDI is approved, there is a 5 month wait for ben-

efits to start. If the SSDI application is initially denied (about 65% of all initial applications are) you can exercise several levels of appeal, starting with simply requesting a reconsideration by Social Security, followed, if necessary, by a hearing with an independent Administrative Law Judge, a review by the SSDI Appeals Council, or even an appeal to Federal Court. Hopefully, if the applicant is now on private long term disability, the SSDI application will be initially approved.

As for whether the spouse of a person on SSDI is affected, much depends on the spouse's age and how the spouse's

own SS retirement benefit compares to the disabled partner's SSDI benefit. Benefits for a spouse are available as early as age 62, but the spouse's personal FRA benefit amount (from their own lifetime earnings record) must be less than 50% of the disabled partner's SSDI amount to get a spousal boost from the disabled spouse. Otherwise, one marriage partner being on SSDI will not affect the other partner's personal Social Security retirement benefit.

busy and we like to engage in systemic activities in our daily lives -- activities that keep us on the go in ways that burn energy. So, does that count as "exercise?" The consensus is that it just might.

National Academy of Sports Medicine [NASM] says "Absolutely, cleaning your house is exercise. While you may not be in a gym pumping iron or running on a treadmill, it is still exercise and requires you to work and burn more energy than being sedentary. Cleaning the house is an example of moderate intensity activity, the kind the NASM and

health experts recommend that you perform daily to maximize health and fitness. Daily chores like cleaning your house, mowing the lawn, cleaning the car, shopping for food and other things are all examples of moderate exercise, which helps improve health and fitness."

As always, says the Association of Mature American Citizens [AMAC], when it comes to matters of health, it's always a good idea to consult with your health-care provider. So rather than "guessing" that your daily chores provide the exercise you need, make a list and check it with your doctor.

energy bill. Some contractors will even insist on a tour of your home. These individuals may offer to install filters, thermostats, or other energy equipment to lower your bill, or they may say simply you are eligible to pay less. In either case, they'll ask you to sign a contract and possibly even run a credit check. They will also ask for billing information, including your debit or credit card number.

In the end, you won't receive any discount on your energy bill or any services. The equipment you were promised won't be delivered. That's because this "home energy audit" is a scam. You may, however, be

charged the fees mentioned in the contract, and your personal information will be in the hands of a scammer.

How to avoid impersonation scams:

- Don't agree to anything on the spot. No matter how good the deal seems or how urgent the individual makes their offer seem, take time to do your research. Tell the person you need time to think about their offer and hang up or close the door. Scammers may tell you you'll miss out on the deal, but taking immediate action isn't worth getting scammed.
- Go to the source. Contact your local government agency or your utility company directly

to confirm whether they really are offering energy audit services. This is the quickest way to find out if you are dealing with an impostor.

- Get help. If you aren't sure about what you're being offered, talk to someone. Call a trusted friend or family member or contact your local BBB to find out if it you are dealing with a scam.
