➔ THREE THINGS You Should Know:

1 Meyers says some weeds are inevitable, but there are ways to make gardens a place where weeds have a hard time growing. Weeds can be introduced through the seeds, plants and compost that gardeners buy. He recommends checking labels on these items and making sure they come from reputable sources. When planting, choosing local species that grow well in the area can outcompete weeds. Increasing the number of plants in a garden and eliminating empty spaces keep weeds out as well. When removing weeds, it is important to remove as much of the plant as possible. Garden tools such as hoes can make this process easier. Meyers says herbicides can be used in home gardens in certain circumstances. Gardeners should read and follow the labels and wear proper protective equipment to stay safe. Gloves, long pants and closed-toe shoes should be worn while using herbicides.

2 The Postal Service is reminding customers that metallic mercury and devices containing metallic mercury are always prohibited in the mail stream. This includes antique items such as thermometers, barometers, blood pressure monitors and similar devices. However, compact fluorescent lamps, which contain small amounts of mercury in vapor form, are mailable domestically but not internationally.

3 On April 8, 2024, a total solar eclipse will pass over a large stretch of the United States, beginning in Texas, crossing Indiana and exiting through Maine. Caldwell says special eclipse glasses are needed to view this event safely. These glasses are about a million times more powerful than regular sunglasses. When buying online, people should make sure their eclipse glasses are safe to use by looking for ISO (International Organization for Standardization) and CE certification. Caldwell encourages people to order eclipse glasses sooner rather than later. In the months leading up to an eclipse, more people will order, and glasses will become less available.

Ask Rusty - Why Can't I Collect Survivor Benefits From My Deceased Wife?

Dear Rusty: I am a 62 year old widower that is still working full time. While my late spouse was in hospice, I was able to get her to apply for Social Security disability and she received one payment before she passed away two years ago. I was told that I could collect a survivor benefit, so I called my local Social Security office, but they told me that I could not collect any type of benefits from my wife and that all the money she paid into SS for all of those years was basically gone for good. Would you please advise what I can do and if this is true? I was also told that Social Security's agents will do everything they can to avoid paying out benefits. Signed: Frustrated Widower

Assuming you have not yet claimed your personal SS retirement benefit, you are still eligible to collect a survivor benefit from your wife when your earnings are less or after you reach your full retirement age. One strategy you may wish to consider, if you plan to keep working full time, is to wait and claim only your surviving spouse benefit at your FRA (67), thus allowing your personal SS retirement benefit to continue growing until you are 70 when your personal SS retirement benefit will be about 75% more than it would be now. Although your survivor benefit reaches maximum at your FRA, your personal benefit doesn't reach maximum until age 70, so it's possible to collect your smaller survivor benefit from your wife first and claim your higher personal benefit later.

You were apparently given some confusing information when you contacted Social Security. If you haven't already claimed your own SS retirement benefit, you are still eligible for a surviving spouse benefit from your wife but likely cannot collect a widower benefit at this

time because you're working full time. However, that doesn't mean you can never collect a survivor benefit; only that you can't collect it at this time because of the "earnings test." The earnings test goes away when you reach age 67, so you can claim only your survivor benefit at that time (or before if you no longer work full time) and allow your personal SS retirement benefit to continue to grow (to age 70 if you like).

From our experience with the Social Security Administration, the skill level of SSA representatives varies but we have never suspected their goal was trying to avoid paying benefits due. Nevertheless, depending on the agent you spoke with, the information provided may have been less clear about the best claiming strategy for you - which is why the AMAC Foundation's Social Security Advisory Service exists. Our advisors are all highly experienced and strive to provide you with complete and clear information which enables you to make an informed choice about how and when to claim the Social Security benefits you are entitled to. I hope we have succeeded.

Dear Frustrated Widower: I suspect that the reason Social Security said you were not eligible for benefits as a widower is because you are working full time. At age 62, you are subject to Social Security's "earnings test" which limits how much you can earn while collecting early Social Security benefits. The 2023 earnings limit is \$21,240 and, if that is exceeded, SS will take away \$1 in benefits for every \$2 you are over the limit. If your earnings are high enough, that could make you temporarily ineligible to collect benefits until 1) your earnings are less, or 2) you reach your full retirement age (FRA) when the earnings test no longer applies.

When Fast Is Not Fast Enough

Experts predicted the failure of commercial supersonic air travel long before the first Concorde took off on January 21, 1976 ushering in a short-lived era of Super Sonic Travel [SST]. On that day a British Airways SST took off from London's Heathrow Airport headed for Bahrain in the Persian Gulf and an Air France SuperJet flew from Paris to Rio de Janeiro, both carrying plane loads of passengers. After all, the Concorde was a British-French joint venture.

However, try as they might, the Concorde was inefficient and very expensive to maintain. And at least one commercial aviation expert warned that despite the plane's cruising speed of about 1,500 miles per

hour, it was too slow to make it worth the exorbitant cost of a seat. An average round trip New York-London ticket, according to the Smithsonian Magazine, set you back about \$12,000 in 1976. According to the CPI Inflation Calculator, that's the equivalent of \$63,656 today. Alas, the last flight of the Concorde took place in 2003. But efforts are underway to build a better, more efficient SST airplane.

The website, Jalopnik, reports that supersonic travel is not a thing of the past, that there is a market of "wealthy airline passengers" who await "the return of faster-than-sound transit" and that there are several companies focused on delivering "the spiritual succes-

Road Work Ahead

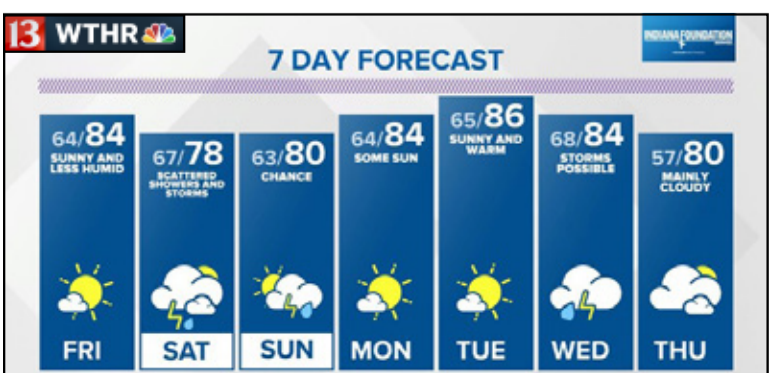

Addressing Housing Needs Art On Thursday – July 27 Watercolor

Indiana's cost of living ranks lower than the national average, making our state one of the most affordable

places to live in the country. Yet, many Hoosiers today are grappling with housing shortages and rising prices. It's only a start, but I was proud to support the following measures to help Hoosiers find and keep their homes.

Following major tax cuts, taxpayers are projected to save \$109 million in property-tax relief and more than \$100 million in income-tax relief in 2024 alone.

A new law expands property-tax deduction

and property-tax credit eligibility for senior-citizen homeowners, so an estimated 9,000 more seniors can be eligible for Indiana's existing over-65 homestead deduction and credit.

Lawmakers created the State and Local Tax Review Task Force to study Indiana's tax system, including income and property taxes, and consider measures that will keep more money in taxpayers' pockets in the years to come.

The new 2024-25 state budget allocates \$5 million for homelessness prevention grants to help those struggling to keep their homes and \$75 million for the Residential Housing Infrastructure Assistance Program to spur housing development in Indiana communities. Hoosiers should

never live without a roof over their head.

As your state senator, I will continue to support measures that help Hoosier families own and maintain a home.

sor to the Concorde very soon. American Airlines and United have both put deposits down on one company's supersonic jet — the Boom Supersonic Overture — that promises to be in passenger service by 2029.”

As fast as SSTs are, one of the reasons that the Concorde failed in the end was the fact that the three hours or so that it took that plane to travel from New York to London was not fast enough to make its high cost worth it. High rollers are not willing to pay the premium to simply cut little more than three hours off their trip; they want to be able to fly to London in an hour or so, have a business lunch and get back to New York in time to have a late afternoon cocktail before dinner. Thus, the new focus is on the creation of hypersonic passenger aircraft.

Retired Air Force Brigadier General Blaine Holt recently told Newsmax that the next horizon as regards commercial airfare is decidedly hypersonic. As he

put it, "People are turning away from folks who think our best days are behind us undaunted and going into science and tech. We are coming back to something that is in our bones as a nation. Hypersonics, and the science that spins off of it, is so exciting."

The Newsmax report explains that while the SSTs of yore traveled at about Mach 2 or 1,535 miles per hour, a hypersonic flies at a speed of Mach 9 or more than 6,900 miles an hour, making it possible to fly from New York to Tokyo in about an hour - a trip that today takes conventional airliners more than 14 hours. The report focuses on the work in progress of Venus Aerospace of Houston, TX. It's working on a hypersonic aircraft that can carry about a dozen passengers at Mach 9.

Hermeus in Atlanta, GA says it is planning to have a plane that could get passengers from New York to Paris in an hour and a half and that it will be ready by 2029.

according to the National Council for Patient Information and Education.

Following a doctor's recommended care plan can be challenging, according to Dr. J.B. Sobel, chief medical officer with Cigna Healthcare's Medicare business. There are multiple reasons why older patients can have difficulty following their provider's instructions - including managing multiple medications at different times of day - or trouble accessing or affording care.

Thankfully, there are some processes and resources that can help you faithfully follow your healthcare provider's advice.

Get organized. More than half of adults 65 and older take four or more prescription drugs, according to the Kaiser Family Foundation. With more medications, it can be difficult to know what to take, when to take it, and in what dosage. A low-cost pill organizer, available at drug stores and retail outlets, can help you stay organized. You may also want to automate your medication by taking it at the same time every day if directions allow that. The key is to find a system that works for you and stick with it.

Communicate with your provider or pharmacist. If your medication doesn't seem to be working or is causing undesirable side effects, talk to your doctor or pharmacist about adjusting your dosage or switching to an alternative. Likewise, discuss any concerns about screenings or tests with your provider.

Having a good rapport with your doctor helps. Take notes at your appointment or bring a loved one with you to help with questions. And don't be afraid to ask if there's anything you don't understand.

Connect your providers. Make sure your various doctors share information. For example, if you have an unexpected hospital visit, notify your primary care provider so they can review any new medications or diagnoses from the hospital and help you

fit them into your current care plan. This can also help protect you from unnecessary or duplicate procedures.

Find alternative access to care. If you have difficulty getting around or live far from where care is rendered, there are programs to help. Your provider may offer virtual visits. You may be able to have prescriptions safely delivered to your home in a 90-day supply, perhaps at a lower cost, and with reminders for refills. If you have a Medicare Advantage plan, you may be eligible for rides to your provider or pharmacy at no extra cost. Learn more about Cigna Healthcare's Medicare Advantage plans at www.cigna.com/medicare.

Seek help with costs. "Extra Help" is a federal program providing prescription drug cost support to those who qualify. Many pharmaceutical manufacturers help customers afford medications. You could also ask your healthcare provider about generic medications, which typically cost less but are equally effective.

Medicare and Medicare Advantage plans pay for many preventive procedures with no extra cost to you.

"If keeping up with your health care feels overwhelming, please don't get discouraged," said Dr. Sobel, who oversees a team of clinicians that contact Cigna Healthcare's Medicare Advantage customers whose prescriptions have lapsed or not been refilled.
