Boomer Bits

Ask Rusty - I'm 64. When Should I Claim My Social Security?

Dear Rusty: I am 64 years old and still working full time. My question is - when should I start my Social Security? I would like to start it in January 2024 and go part time at work, but would I be losing much Social Security by not waiting until full retirement age? Signed: Trying to Plan Ahead

Dear Trying, to Plan: You are smart to evaluate the impact of claiming your Social Security (SS) benefits early. First, be aware that your full retirement age (FRA) for Social Security purposes is 66 years and 8 months, and that is when you get 100% of the SS benefit you've earned from a lifetime of working.

It appears you already know that if you start benefits before your FRA, you'll be subject to Social Security's "earnings test" which limits how much you can earn from working before they take away some of your benefits. But if you go part time at work you can mitigate the earnings test and claim your benefits early - just understand that your payment will be permanently reduced by doing so.

If you claim your benefits to start in January 2024, you'll be taking your Social Security about 18 months early, which means that instead of 100% of your FRA entitlement you'll get about 90% (a reduction of 10%). The earnings test will still apply, and we don't yet know what the 2024 earnings limit will be, but it will be something more than the 2023 limit of \$21,240. If your 2024 earnings exceed the annual limit, SS will take away \$1 in benefits for every \$2 you are over the limit. They "take away" benefits by withholding future payments until they recover what you owe for exceeding the limit. If you work part time and don't exceed the 2024 annual earnings limit, there will be no

penalty and you will get every month's SS payment. If you find you will exceed the annual 2024 earnings limit, you can call Social Security and inform them of that and by how much, and they will suspend your benefits for the number of months necessary to avoid overpaying you. If you don't inform them and you exceed the annual 2024 limit, they will catch up in 2025 when they get your 2024 earnings info from the IRS and issue an Overpayment Notice requiring you to pay back the amount owed (half of what you exceeded the 2024 annual limit by). As you likely know, the earnings test no longer applies after you reach your full retire-

Short Of Breath? It Could Be Interstitial Lung Disease

(StatePoint) It is estimated that about 250,000 Americans are living with idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis (IPF) and scleroderma associated ILD, two types of interstitial lung disease (ILD) that can make breathing difficult.

During September, which is Pulmonary Fibrosis Awareness Month, the American Lung Association, with support from Boehringer Ingelheim, is providing support and resources to those impacted by ILD. As part of the educational campaign, they are sharing these important facts and insights:

What is ILD? Interstitial lung disease is an umbrella term used for a large group of diseases that cause scarring (fibrosis) of the lungs. The scarring causes stiffness that makes it difficult to breathe and get oxygen to the bloodstream. Lung damage from ILDs is often irreversible and gets worse over time, however treatment is available to help relieve symptoms.

Who is at risk? While anyone can get interstitial lung disease, many things can increase the

risk of ILD or even cause it, including genetics and certain medications or medical treatments, like radiation or chemotherapy. Smoking can not only cause ILDs, but can make the condition much worse, which is why anyone diagnosed is strongly encouraged to quit. Additionally, people with autoimmune diseases such as scleroderma -- also called systemic sclerosis -- are at an increased risk of developing an ILD. Unfortunately, in the case of idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis, the cause is unknown.

What are the symptoms of ILD? The most common symptom of all ILDs is shortness of breath. This is often accompanied by a dry cough, chest discomfort, fatigue and occasionally, weight loss.

How is ILD diagnosed? Healthcare providers test for ILD through a chest X-ray or CT scan. A lung function test may be used to measure total lung capacity, which may have deteriorated due to the ILD. In more serious cases, and

Montgomery County Legislators Seek Statehouse Interns For 2024 Session

Local lawmakers are seeking interns to join them at the Statehouse during the 2024 legislative session.

According to State Rep. Beau Baird (R-Greencastle), House interns will be paid \$900 bi-weekly as they work in downtown Indianapolis during session, which starts in January and concludes mid-March.

"There aren't many internships like this one where you can meet officials and industry leaders from across the state," Baird said. "So many have used this experience to learn about potential careers and meet employers."

State Rep. Jeff Thompson (R-Lizton) said

House internships are open to college students and recent graduates of all majors.

"Interning with the Indiana House of Representatives is a great opportunity for young professionals to gain valuable skills that they can apply in the workforce," Thompson said. "From communicating with Hoosiers around the state to assisting with media requests, House interns manage important tasks and help session run more smoothly."

Paid, spring-semester intern positions are full-time, Monday through Friday, and include free parking, career and professional development assistance, enrollment

access to an Indiana government class, and opportunities to earn academic credits through the student's college or university. Interns are also eligible to apply for a competitive \$3,000 scholarship to use toward undergraduate and graduate expenses.

"Statehouse internships allow students to explore career opportunities and develop talents that can help them in the future," said State Rep. Sharon Negele (R-Attica). "These positions provide ways to dive into several different industries and career paths while learning and developing professionally."

According to State Rep. Mark Genda

(R-Frankfort), students can apply for internships in a variety of departments related to their field of study, including legislative operations, policy, and communications and media relations.

"This internship builds on classroom knowledge, and students and graduates can gain experience they can utilize in any career field," Genda said. "Our interns can learn skills not only related to their interests, but also gain confidence working in a professional setting."

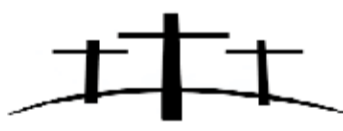

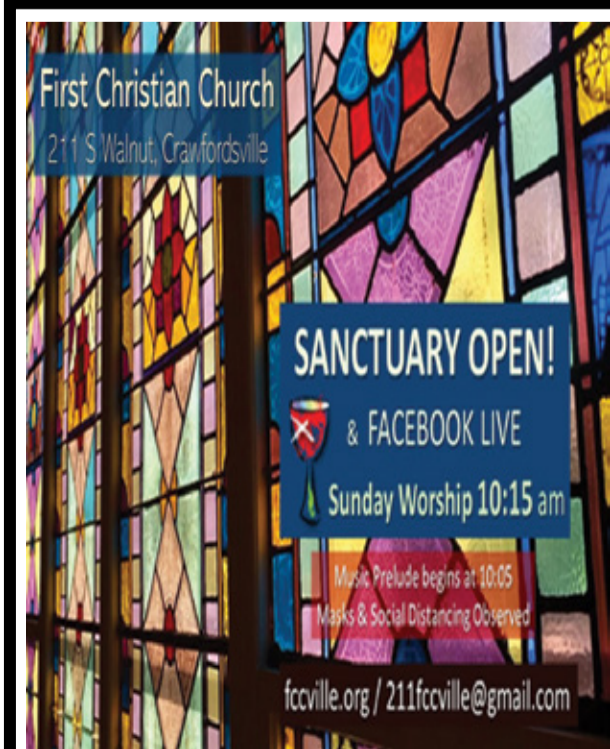

Law Enforcement Cracking Down On Impaired Driving From Border To Border

Indiana troopers are joining other troopers along the nation's interstate corridors to deter impaired driving during the Labor Day weekend.

The border-to-border enforcement effort is taking place as a part of the Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over enforcement campaign. The overtime patrols are funded by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) through the Indiana Criminal Justice Institute (ICJI).

As part of the enforcement effort, law enforcement agencies nationwide will be focusing efforts along I-70, I-80, I-90 and I-94. Troopers will be taking drivers under the influence of drugs or alcohol off the roads.

As drivers are making their way along Indiana roads, including these major interstates, they should make sure to drive safely. "There is no excuse for

driving impaired on alcohol or drugs," said Devon McDonald, ICJI Executive Director. "Impaired driving is incredibly risky not only for the person making the choice to drive impaired but for everyone else on the road."

About 37 people die in the U.S. in drunk driving crashes every day. That's approximately one person every 39 minutes and more than 13,384 annually, according to NHTSA.

Of the 949 traffic fatalities that occurred last year in Indiana, 110, or 12 percent, were alcohol related. While that is a decline from 115 in 2021, there is still a long way to go.

During the 2021 Labor Day holiday period (6 p.m. September 3-5:59 a.m. September 7), there were 531 crash fatalities nationwide. Of these 531 traffic crash fatalities, 41% (216) involved a drunk driver, and more than a quarter (27%)

involved drivers who were driving with a BAC almost twice the legal limit (.15+ BAC).

In Indiana, it is illegal to drive with a BAC of .08 or higher. In addition, drivers under 21 with a BAC of .02 or higher are subject to fines and a license suspension for up to one year. Motorists who encounter a drunk driver on the road are encouraged to call 911.

Impaired driving includes more than just alcohol. Drugs and even some over-the-counter medications can also cause impairment and can slow coordination, judgment and reaction times on the road.

"The number of drivers testing positive for THC and poly-drug use is a growing problem that can have deadly consequences," said Jim Bryan, ICJI Traffic Safety Director. "We are working to address this issue by

training more officers and providing new tools to law enforcement. But the best way to prevent impaired driving is for people to not drive high or under the influence of any other drugs. If you are going to drink or use drugs, have a plan to get home safely. Call a cab, ride-share service, or a friend or family member. Don't risk your life and the lives of others."

To further prevent drunk driving, ICJI's Sober Ride Indiana program is running a special holiday campaign in Ft. Wayne and Indianapolis. From September 3 through September 4, the program is offering \$15 off Uber and Lyft rides up to 500 redemptions per day.

Ride credits are only available between the hours of 5 p.m. and 3 a.m. while supplies last. To redeem a discounted ride, visit SoberRideIndiana.com.

Donald Trump in New York, Miami, and D.C. The president, along with 18 other Americans, have been indicted for taking actions that are protected by the Constitution. As an example, John Eastman, was just indicted in Georgia for his role in combating election fraud, despite his efforts being constitutionally protected. So essentially, it seems the Biden administration is now criminalizing actions that are protected by the Constitution."

Ms. Habba went on to note that "we have a dual system of justice" in America these days. "You're treated one way if you are a Republican and another if you're a Democrat. More importantly, if you're a Republican and your name is Trump you are treated in the most unfair manner." She compared the treatment of President Trump with that of Hunter Biden and she said "we've seen it with the targeting and systemic scheduling of trials during the campaign for the Republican Party. They're kind of laying it out for us and it's hard to ignore at this point. We're on indictment number four."

She suggested that Mr. Trump's enemies are seeking to surround him with litigation. "What they've done is change the venue. We have now a federal venue, criminal prosecution, state venue, criminal prosecutions. I believe that that's all by design. As we know, the president, if President Trump is elected again, can pardon himself from federal crimes, but not state. So I think what they're doing is a strategic coordinated dance, for lack of a better word. Georgia's Fulton County District Attorney, Fannie Willis, [is] seeking a trial date of March 4th. The day before the presidential primaries on Super Tuesday. This was announced shortly after the indictment leak before the grand jury was even

convened. So, where does a prosecutorial overreach become malicious prosecution?"

Ms. Habba pointed out that President Trump is being fast-tracked on all his cases, and they're basically all being heard from October until the summer during what is the prime campaign season. "Each of these trials are going to take four to six weeks. [It will] tie up the presidential candidate for the better part of 6 months, and we're not only talking about his criminal cases, but there's civil cases as well. It's by design [and] it's unfair and malicious. It's beyond anything I've ever seen." But she added she thinks it may be encouraging his voters and independents to vote him back into office. In fact, Ms. Habba said, people have been coming up to her and to her co-workers telling them that they didn't like his tweets, that they didn't like this or that but now they are telling us that they are a hundred percent behind Mr. Trump.

Rebecca Weber asked Ms. Habba if it is possible that the Trump team can go directly to the Supreme Court to dismiss or stay the cases against him. Her response was that it would be unethical to go into detail. She said her team is focused on "making sure we remove cases that need to be removed into federal court, that we, request appeals or decisions that are appropriate. We can't just do things willy-nilly, we have to have cause. And, we have a great team on the ground with all of these cases and several teams, frankly, that I work with that I'm fortunate to work with every day. They know what to do. And what I would say to the American people is not to worry. We have very intelligent people working for the president. They are well seasoned attorneys. They have had many successes on very challenging cases. And to me, these cases are frankly bogus."

to diagnose a specific type of ILD, more invasive procedures may be needed, such as a lung biopsy or bronchoscopy, which employs a small camera located at the end of a flexible tube that takes photos and collects tissue samples of the air passages.

How can ILD be managed? It is recommended that patients with idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis stay active and eat well. They may also be encouraged to use oxygen therapy as prescribed to help manage their condition. In some cases, the condition can be slowed by certain medications, and occasionally, people with IPF will be recommended for lung transplant.

Where can patients find support? Two new educational webcasts -- "Newly Diagnosed with ILD" and "Living with ILD" -- will provide education, resources and support to

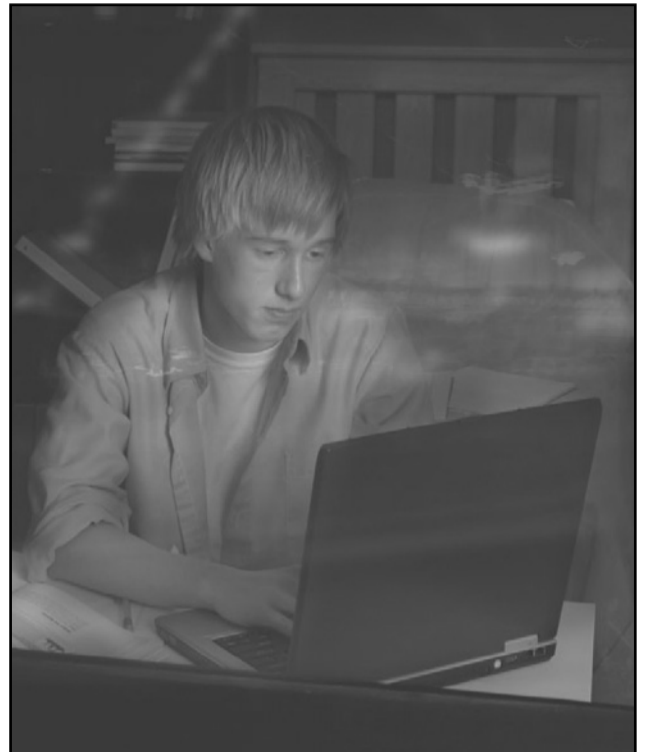
patients and their loved ones. Both webcasts will feature a healthcare provider and patient, and will be made available on-demand after the live showing. ment age. So, the decision on when to claim your Social Security benefit is yours to make, and you are smart to consider your work plans - but should also consider your life expectancy and marital status. If you are married and eventually die before your lower earning spouse, your spouse's benefit as your survivor will be based on your benefit amount at the time of your death. Thus, your age when you claim your benefit may also affect your spouse's benefit as your survivor; the longer you wait (up to age 70) the more your spouse's survivor benefit would

be. And if you enjoy at least average longevity, which is about 84 for a man your current age, then by waiting until your FRA or later to claim you'll not only get a higher monthly payment but also get more in cumulative lifetime benefits. If, however, your financial circumstances are such that you need the SS money sooner, then claiming earlier may be the right decision, provided you don't substantially exceed the annual earnings limit prior to reaching your full retirement age. I hope the above provides what you need to make an informed decision.
